Climbers' Handbook v.1

This handbook is provided for the information of climbers wishing to participate in the event. The details may change without notice.

The 2011 National Climbing Titles and Round 2 of the Oceania Series will be hosted by Bayside Rock. The results from this event will determine the Australian Champions for 2011 and also count towards your Oceania Series score.

1. Location:

2. Dates:

- The event will be held on the **30th & 31st July, 2011**

3. Categories:

There will be male and female categories in:

- Youth A – born 1994/1995
- Youth B – born 1996/1997
- Youth C – born 1998/1999
- Youth D – born 2000 or after
- Junior – born 1992/1993
- Masters – (40+ /born 1971 or before)
- Open B – Climbers climbing up to grade 24 (male) and grade 22 (female) (Nationals Only)
- Open A – Everyone else!

4. The Event:

4.01 All Australian competitors must be current members of Sport Climbing Australia. This costs only \$15 for the calendar year.

4.02 The entry fees are as follows:

Lead Climbing: \$55

Lead Climbing (second category): \$35 (Youth A & Junior only)

Speed Climbing: \$15

4.03 Please pay on the day during registration times or before hand at Bayside Rock.

5. Lead:

5.01 The Lead event will include 2 heats for each category. (Onsight and/or flash for open, Flash for everyone else) This will be followed by an onsight final for the top 8 climbers in each category.

- 5.02** The National Ranking in each category will be decided by **placing in the onsight final (Australians ONLY)**. Count-back to the heats will be used in the result of a tie in the final.
- 5.03** The Oceania Ranking (round 2) in each category will be decided by **placing in the onsight final**. Count-back to the heats will be used in the result of a tie in the final.
- 5.04** Prizes will be awarded for the Oceania Series and Trophies will be awarded for the Australian Nationals.
- 5.05** As this is a National climbing competition the routes will be set accordingly which means they may be hard right off the ground and set to a National standard. All care will be taken to enable climbers to enjoy their heats but a high standard of climbing will be expected and climbers should not be disappointed if they fail in meeting the national standard.
- 5.06** Climbers in **Youth C, Youth D and Open B** categories will **top-rope** all routes. (Subject to change)
- 5.07** Climbers in **Open A, Masters, Junior, Youth A & Youth B** categories will **lead** all routes. (Subject to change)
- 5.08** Climbers who are **colour-blind/ have special needs** must notify the routesetters at Bayside Rock by at least the 20th of July 2011.
- 5.09** Climbers are asked to **pre-register** at <http://www.baysiderock.com.au> by 20th July 2011.
- 5.10** **Category numbers are limited so pre register ASAP. Priority will be given to climbers who qualified in the top 8 of their state and places will be shared evenly between states where required.**

6. Speed:

- 6.01** Heats for the speed event will be held throughout the day
- 6.02** Finals for the fastest 8 competitors in each category, from the heats, will be held at the conclusion of the last Heats on Saturday.

6. Interim Timetable:

- Times are approximate and will vary depending on the running of the event. All climbers are advised to be at the event and ready to climb at all times.
- When booking flights please leave plenty of time in case the event runs over!
